Update on Negotiations - Move to Fact Finding



Regular negotiations have concluded. The Union and the District moved to mediation.

The mediation only lasted for <u>3</u> hours as the the District's offer for 2020-2021 still remains a <u>0% pay</u> increase.



Inflation in the Los Angeles area is estimated to be 8.5%. **We will NOT ACCEPT a 0% increase.**

The negotiations have moved to **fact-finding** where there is a representative from the Union, the District and a third party. We will publish more information as it becomes available.

PERB Complaint

All post-hearing documents and reply briefs were submitted to the judge by April 1st. We expect the judge to render a decision in the next 60 - 90 days. We will post any updates we receive.

FLEX Hours Opportunity!

Adjuncts who attend College sponsored FLEX and approved department activities will earn their regular hourly rate for up to 5 hours and up to an additional 4 hours of FLEX at the non-instructional rate for each summer/fall and winter/spring period.

Approved department activities include: department retreats, department retreat presentations, and departmental trainings that have been approved for FLEX credit.

Adjuncts who have either a winter or spring assignment may attend FLEX activities from January 1st through June 30th. Adjuncts who have a summer or fall assignment may attend FLEX activities from July 1st through December 31st.
